Karen Baldwin Resigns from KIUC Board of Directors

Līhu'e, Kaua'i, HI – 4/20/16 – Karen Baldwin, a member of the board of directors of Kaua'i Island Utility Cooperative, has resigned effective April 18.

Baldwin, an attorney from Princeville who has served on the board since 2012, recently moved to California.

“I have enjoyed my tenure on the board and am proud of the progress KIUC has made over the past five years,” Baldwin said in her resignation letter. “You all have my support and I will watch your continued progress with interest.”

Under the cooperative's bylaws, vacancies for unexpired terms on the nine-member board are filled by an appointment by the remaining directors. Baldwin's term expires in March 2018.

At its regular meeting on April 26, the board will take action on the vacancy.

“I thank Karen for her service to the cooperative and to the community,” said Jan TenBruggencate, chairman of the board of directors. “Karen was a thoughtful advocate for our members and helped move us closer to achieving our renewable energy goals.”
